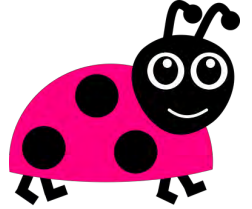


Bug Matching Game:



Use the attached 'bug' pictures. There are 2 copies of each page. Leave one copy as a whole picture board. Cut out the other page of small 'bug' pictures to make pictures to match to the picture board.

Turn over the small picture cards and take turns with your child / children to pick up a small 'bug' card and match it to the picture board page.

When playing the game **TALK with your child / children** about the following:

- Name of the bug (e.g. slug, spider, snail, fly, beetle, lady bird, grasshopper).
- The features of the bugs (e.g. number of legs, colour, wings, spots, antenna) & how they move (e.g. fly, hop, walk).
- How bugs look different (e.g. 'this bug is pink and this bug is green', 'this spider has 8 legs and this bug has no legs').

You could also cut up all of the small 'bug' pictures and play a memory matching card game.
